**E**rnest E. Andry, Jr. (“Bucky”) passed away on January 7, 2010, at home with his family, ending a long and valiant fight with pancreatic cancer. Born September 28, 1939, a native of Algiers and resident of Mandeville for the last 18 years.

Beloved husband of Janice Jordan Andry for 47 years. Father of Michele Alys Andry Richardson (Michael), Jill Elizabeth Andry Giberga (Sam) and Lisa Anne Andry Gargiulo (John). Grandfather of Emily M.
