Henry Kolbe “Rex” Coffman passed away peacefully surrounded by family Monday, July 16, 2007.

Survived by his beloved wife of 47 years of Florence Barbara “Bobbie” Brooks Coffman, daughter Christine Kolbe Coffman Slote, son-in-law Stephen Richard Slote, daughter Roberta Ann Coffman, son Kurt Steven Coffman, his partner Sergio Rodriguez, and granddaughter Kolbe Rae Slote. His mother, Lenora Kolbe Coffman, his father, Gilbert K. Coffman, Sr. and a brother, Gilbert Coffman, Jr, preceded him in death.

Age 82 years old, a native of Woodstock, VA he was a resident of Mandeville, LA. Mr. Coffman was a United States Army Veteran having served during World War II.
