Ruby Mayfield Creswell, 91, of Covington was born in Kinder on February 8, 1920 and died on Thursday, April 28, 2011.

She attended Vincent Business College in Lake Charles where she was named outstanding graduate in 1939. After graduation, she married the love of her life, Paul Creswell and moved to Baton Rouge where she worked alongside Paul, contributing to the success of his business endeavors. The family moved to Covington in 1972 and there they enjoyed an idyllic life on the Tchefuncte River.
