In lieu of flowers, the family requests contributions in memory of Mrs. Daigle to be made to St. Scholastica Academy.



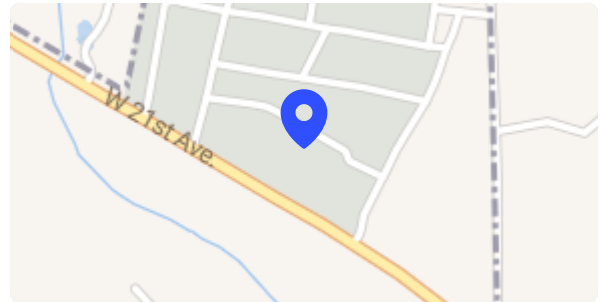
