**J**ohn D. Domec, Jr. passed away on Thursday, July 19, 2012 at the age of 86. He was a native of New Orleans and a resident of Covington for the past 35 years. Mr. Domec served in the Army Air Corps during WW II before beginning a 30 year career as a Producer/Director for WDSU-TV in New Orleans. After locating to Covington, he became a real estate broker and was former President of the St. Tammany Board of Realtors.

He was preceded in death by his first wife, Anna Kastler Domec; his parents Thelma and John Domec; and a brother, Wallace Domec.
