Mrs. Duplessis was born in Mellen and grew up in Omro, Wisconsin. She graduated from St. Agnes Hospital School of Nursing in Fond du Lac. After graduation, she decided to move to a then, brand new, Charity Hospital in New Orleans to care for poor sick children. She worked at Charity for 32 years and retired as the Supervising Registered Nurse for 9th Floor Pediatrics.
