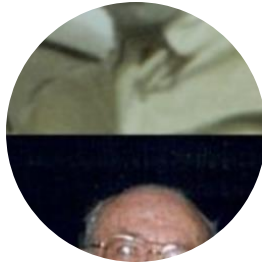

SEP 26, 1923 - MAR 26, 2008

Floyd J. Dupre, 84, entered into eternal rest on Wednesday, March 26, 2008 at home surrounded by loving family and friends.

He was the loving husband of 59 years of Joyce Mary Cortez Dupre; beloved father of Ronnie J. Dupre and wife Debbie and Brenda D. Cortez and husband Larry; grandfather of Elaine Robinson and her husband Keith, Michelle Boudreaux and her husband Blake, Brian Mayeur and his wife Michelle and Clifford Dupre and his wife Nicole; and he was survived by ten great-grandchildren. He is also survived by his sister, Inola Dupre and brother, Austin Dupre, Jr. He was preceded in death by his parents, Austin Dupre, Sr. and Pauline Vasseur Dupre; and two brothers, Clydiss and Turlin Dupre.

Floyd was a veteran of WWII having served as a member of the Army's 2nd Ranger Battalion, Company C. He participated in the Normandy Invasion, climbing the cliffs at Pointe du Hoc, France on D-Day, June 6, 1944. He was also a member of VFW Post 3804 and American Legion Post 401 and a 4th Degree Knight, Knights of Columbus Council N6872. He was a volunteer at the National D-Day Museum for a number of years.
