Barbara Kenny Edwards died on Tuesday, November 18, 2008. She was born in Saginaw, Michigan, the daughter of the late James C. and Marie Shannon Kenny. After high school graduation, she attended the Wheeling Hospital School of Nursing in Wheeling, West Virginia. She then joined the Army Nurse Corp and spent three years in England as a First Lieutenant during World War II. Following Army service, she moved to Madisonville, LA where she worked for the St. Tammany Parish Health Department.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Jack W. Edwards, December 7, 2002.

Surviving are her brother, James (Eleanor) Kenny, a niece Barbara Kenny Chenoweth, two nephews, Tim (Marge) Kenny and Tom (Debbie) Kenny, all of Cadiz, Ohio; and seven great nieces and nephews four great-great nieces and nephews.
