Kelley Ann Pavur Foret, a dedicated child of Christ for most of her life, passed away on Friday, November 28, 2008 at the age of 41 after an eight month battle with a rare form of cancer.

She was born in New Orleans to Charles J. and Jacquelyn Miller Pavur, lived most of her life in New Orleans and Metairie and has been a resident of Covington since 2005.

The beloved mother of her precious Bailey Jacquelyn Foret, she is survived by her brother, Charles J. Pavur, Jr. and his wife Jan; two nephews, Travis and Payton Pavur; one niece, Sarah Pavur and her aunt, Karen Keller Reaves. She was preceded in death by her grandparents: Anna Mae Magash Miller Keller and Clarence Miller, Anna Slichon Pavur Matranga and Paul Pavur. She is the great-granddaughter of the late Hazel Cook Magash and Nicholas Magash.
