**H**enry J. Guidry Jr., passed away at Colonial Nursing Home in Marksville, Louisiana on Thursday, January 3, 2013, aged 98 years. He resided in New Orleans for his first 70 years before moving to Folsom, LA in 1991.

Beloved husband of the late Gladys Krass Guidry and son of the late Henry J. Guidry, Sr. of Convent and the late Leah Cambre of Reserve, LA. Father of Henry J. Guidry, III and Michael R. Guidry Sr. He is also survived by eleven grandchildren and twenty great-grandchildren.
