Jacquelin Caskie Guillot, age 65, died peacefully on Thursday, August 4, 2011. She was home and surrounded by family at her bedside. Jackie battled heart disease, metastatic breast and ovarian cancer.

She is survived by her husband of 45 years Ronald “Ronnie” Benedict Guillot, and four children. Ron Guillot and wife Dr. Alexandra Theriault, Leesa Guillot Tumen and husband George all of whom live in Denver, Colorado as well as Michael Guillot and wife Ashly, and Chris Guillot and wife Lisa, who reside in Mandeville, La. Jackie was the proud grandmother of Hayes, Anna, Remy and Elle. She is also survived by a brother, Bobby Caskie, and sister, Elizabeth Ferguson, and several nieces and nephews.

Jackie was preceded in death by her parents, Robert Ambler Caskie and Anna Yanchuck Caskie.

After a childhood spent in Shreveport, Jackie attended Northwestern State in Natchitoches where she studied art. Jackie and Ronnie raised their family in Algiers before moving to Mandeville in 2004.
