**J**ohn "Pat" Jarrell passed away on Sunday, June 1, 2008. Aged 57 years.

Beloved father of Chablis Tate and her spouse, Matthew Tate of Kentwood, LA. Also survived by two brothers, Doug Jarrell and Don Jarrell, one sister, Nena Faye Glaze, one niece and four nephews. Preceded in death by the late Alex "Jack" Jarrell and Julie "Nena" Jarrell.

He had served for two terms on the Tangipahoa Parish Council and two terms on the WST Electric Board. He was a rural postal carrier since 1980. A native of Covington, LA and a resident of Kentwood, LA for the past 28 years.
