Diane Elizabeth Jordan, age 67 of Covington, LA passed away on May 22, 2010. She was preceded in death by her parents, Francis and Elsie Haskell. She graduated High School in Washburn, Maine in 1960 and attended Nursing School at McLean Hospital in Belmont, Mass, where she earned her nursing degree in 1964. She was a nurse in the Air Force Reserves with rank of Captain. She nursed in Boston and Monte Vista, Colorado and was Director of Public Health in Saguache, Colorado until retirement in 2003.

Her loving husband Jack Jordan, MD survives her in the home. In addition she is survived by one son, Christopher (Laura) Small and granddaughter Eleanor of Marblehead, Mass; her sister, Virginia (Richard) Appleby of Lawrenceville, GA, nieces Karen and Lisa, nephews Steven and Danny and their families.
