Warren Benedict Kempff, at the age of 89, went to be with our Lord on Friday, March 21, 2008.

Born in New Orleans, LA on September 15, 1918, to the late Otto V. Kempff and the late Leona Senac Kempff, he was a graduate of Jesuit High School. He was a Sergeant in the Army Air Force from 1942 until 1945 and then a member of the IBEW, Local 130, for 67 years.
