Carolyn Edwards Magee passed away on March 15, 2011 in Covington, Louisiana.

A memorial service will be held at E.J. Fielding Funeral Home, 2260 W. 21st Avenue, Covington, LA 70433 on Saturday, March 19 at 2:00 p.m. with visitation at 1:00 p.m. Carolyn was the beloved wife of Doyle Magee Jr. She was the mother of Wendy White Gough (husband Matt Gough) of St. Petersburg, Florida. She was the stepmother of Doyle Magee III and Marc Christian Magee. She was the sister-in-law of Sue Magee Bollin (husband Bob). Carolyn was the eldest of four sisters. Survivors are Evelyn Smith (husband Donald Smith) of Munich, Germany, Kathleen Griffith (husband Chuck) of Central City, Nebraska, and Colleen LacoX (husband Gary) of Diboll, Texas. She was the grandmother of Maxwell Gough and Molly Gough. She is survived by 4 nieces and 3 nephews and 8 great nieces and nephews.

Carolyn was born on Nov. 8, 1942 in Columbia, South Carolina. She was preceded in death by her father Marion Earl McMillan, her mother Marie Edwards and her adoptive father Everette Edwards and her stepson Marc Christian Magee.

Carolyn graduated from Hammond High School and was an alumnus of Southeastern Louisiana University.
