Joyce Dupre Matherne passed away Friday, December 18, 2009 at her home in Mandeville, LA. She was born April 26, 1937 to the late Paul Ernest and Lucy Porche Dupre in Houma, LA and has been a resident of Mandeville since 1975. The beloved wife of the late Lee Joseph Matherne, Sr., she is survived by one daughter: Penny Ann Matherne Dastugue (Quentin); three sons: Lee Joseph, Jr. (Margaret), Kenneth Lee and Michael Lawrence Matherne; three sisters: Iona Jean Colwart, Joan Ann Sevin, Judy Tabor and 11 grandchildren: Lee J., III, Chea M., Barry J., Maci A., Joseph T., Alayna L., Olivia K. and Christian M. Matherne, Kaitlin C., Margaux T. and Allison L. Dastugue. She was preceded in death by one son, Barry Joseph Matherne and her brother, Terry Paul Dupre.

Joyce pursued a career in the petroleum industry as a young woman. Working her way from an assistant to the president to acting president, chairman of the board and finally a consultant for Superior Casing Crews, Inc., she excelled when faced with challenges.
