Aldridge L. "Red" McMurray, Jr. passed away on Saturday, November 14, 2009. Beloved father of Amy M. Huerta and her husband Alfredo; loving grandfather to Adela Huerta; brother of Mildred M. Sherburne and her husband Richard and Betsy Ann M. Murphey and her husband John; special friends, Nina Barnett, Frank Hanna and Thekla Hanna; and uncle to numerous nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his mother, Lottie Mae Trudell McMurray; and his father, Aldridge L. McMurray, Sr.

Age 75 years, he was a native of Baton Rouge, LA and a resident of Folsom, LA for the past 29 years.
