Lynndle Patterson Nuss, age 81, of Covington, LA died on Thursday, January 16, 2014 surrounded by family and friends in Mandeville, LA. She was born on Tuesday, December 20, 1932 in Breckenridge, TX.

Lynn was the beloved mother of Brenda Nuss Read (Tom), Bruce Nuss (Susan), Nancy Nuss Ferger (Henry), Sharon Nuss Meilleur (Chris) and son-in-law Jeff Marion. Lynn was a dedicated nurse, beginning her career at Lakeside Hospital and working in Labor and Delivery for 36 years, most recently at St. Tammany Hospital where she retired as a Hospice Nurse in 2004. Throughout her career, she developed close relationships with the patients and families she cared so deeply for. Lynn was famously direct and unwavering in her preferences. She "told it like it was" for 81 years while managing to be compulsively generous, compassionate and endearing to all those in her life.
