**J**oseph Louis Paretti, Sr., passed away on Thursday, March 6, 2008.

Beloved father of Joseph Louis Paretti, Jr.; the late Craig Anthony Paretti, Sr.; and father-in-law of Willie Paretti. Loving grandfather to Robyn Paretti Marsh and her husband Paul, Stacey Paretti Rase and her husband Michael, Craig Anthony Paretti, Jr. and his wife Melissa; and Kylee Paretti LeJeune and her husband Dane; special friend Sheila Berry;. He was also survived by nine great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his first wife, Reba Marion Weaver Paretti; second wife, Kay Fitzmorris Paretti; mother, Loretta Orthman Paretti; and father Joseph Anthony Paretti.
