Helen May Schopp Ross passed away on Sunday, April 11, 2010 at the age of 102, a month before her 103rd birthday.

Mrs. Ross was predeceased by her beloved husband of 65 years, Louis Dumser Ross, and her dear daughter, Helen Catherine "Kay" Ross Brandt.

She was born on May 12, 1907 in New Orleans to Charles J. and Helen Brand Schopp and was the sister of Laetitia Schopp, Charles Schopp, Leonard Schopp, Althea Ross and Norbert Schopp, all of whom predeceased her.

She is survived by her devoted son, Louis D. Ross, Jr. and his wife, Betty; her adoring grandchildren and their spouses: Mary (David) Mizell, John "Jeb" (Anne) Brandt III, Laura Brandt (Lloyd) Alberts, Tina (Mark) Brantley, Joanna (Tyler) Case, Louis D. During her lifetime, Mrs. Ross was very active in civic and social organizations in the Covington area. She was a volunteer with the American Red Cross during World War II, was a Charter Member of both the Covington Garden Club and the Krewe of Juno carnival club, and was a member of the St. Tammany Parish Hospital Guild and the St. Peter Catholic Church Altar Society where she was a long-time parishioner.
