Michael Allen Scaife passed away on Saturday, January 9, 2010.

Beloved father of Adelia Elizabeth Scaife and Michael Eugene Scaife, his wife Roslyn Dawn, and children Caroline Emily, Joshua Michael and Sophia Dawn; loving brother to Robert Perry Scaife and Bette Jean Hamman. He was preceded in death by his mother, Jean Alexander Scaife; and his father, Norman C. Scaife.

Age 60 years, he was native of Memphis, TN and a resident of Covington, LA.
