Pat was born in New Orleans and lived in Covington for the past thirty-eight years. Pat is predeceased by her father and mother, Alfred William Webster and Marietta Lafaso Webster. She is survived by her beloved husband of forty-seven years, Bob, and her children and their spouses: Allyson Sigerson and her fiancé Les Miller, Marietta and Greg Davis, and Richard and Jennifer Sigerson.
