Hubert E. Talley passed away on Sunday, June 7, 2009 at age 82 at Lane Regional Medical Center in Zachary, LA. A life resident of Covington, he lived the last 2 ½ years at the Louisiana War Veterans home in Jackson, LA.

The beloved husband of Ouida Taylor Talley for almost 65 years, he is survived by four sons: G.A. "Al", Joel E., Robert T. and Richard H. Talley; two brothers: Russell and Amos "Bill" Talley; 10 grandchildren and 11 great-grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his parents, James and Edna King Talley and two brothers, John T.
