**E**lizabeth Sue Hooker Marlar Vreeland passed away on Saturday, May 26, 2007 at her Mandeville, LA residence.

She was born on July 16, 1922 in Memphis, TN to the late Thomas E. Hooker and the late Thelma Murphy Hooker. Beloved wife of the late Fred S. Vreeland and late Luther W. Marlar; mother of Thomas L. Marlar and his wife Julia; grandmother of Jessica Richoux and her husband Chad, Elizabeth Marlar and Katherine Marlar; great grandmother of Elise, Christian, Chad Jr., and Alyssa; and sister of Norma Battle and the late Thomas M.
