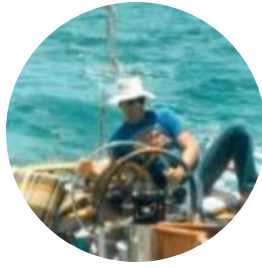

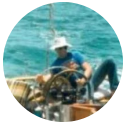
Earl Patrick "Pat" Ward, 68, passed into the loving arms of his Savior on Tuesday, May 18th, 2010.

He is survived by his beloved wife Eva Hall Ward, with whom he shared 43 years of marriage, loving father of Kevin Ward and wife Paula, Stephen Ward and wife Laura and Ashley Ward Gernon and husband Jeff. He is also survived by six grandchildren Benjamin, Samuel and Anna Ward; Gabrielle, Parker and Colton Gernon, a step-grandchild Ryan Lipps, his brother David Ward and sister in law Betty, brother in law Edgar "Pepper" Hall and his aunt Thelma Rabalais.
