Joseph Frank Perry, a retired Certified Public Accountant, passed away on Tuesday, May 6, 2014 at the age of 89.

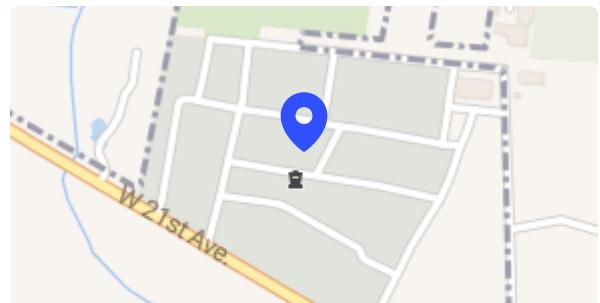
