James Vincent “Jim” Montz, Jr. passed away on Saturday, November 22, 2014 in Covington, LA. He was born on September 18, 1942 in New Orleans, LA to the late James Vincent Montz, Sr. and Clementine Verriere Montz.

Jim was married to his beloved wife, Yvette Marshall Montz, for 49 years and together they had three children, Dan J. Montz (Tina), Dr. Nancy C. Montz (Dr. Kirk Campbell), and David V. Montz (Mitzi). 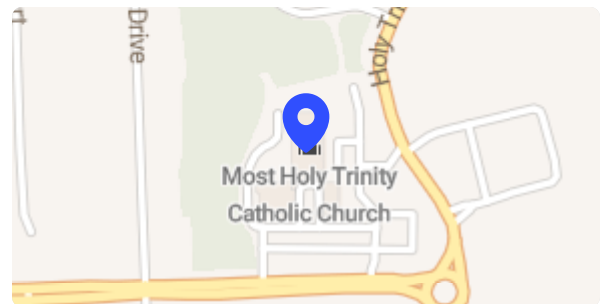

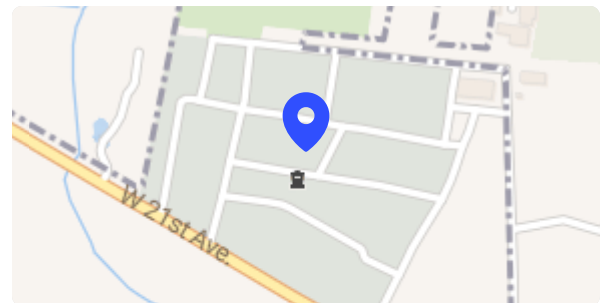

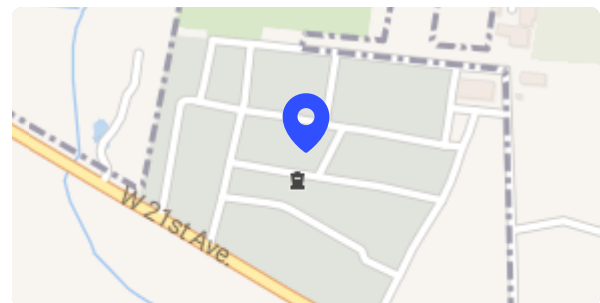
