## Leon Henri Ferrier III

JAN 4, 1929 - SEP 19, 2015

**L**eon Henri Ferrier, III died in Covington, LA on Saturday, September 19, 2015. He was born in New Orleans, LA on January 4, 1929. He was the beloved husband of Carolina Henriette Kusters of Rotterdam, Holland. He was the loving father of Annette F. Hays (Greg) of Atlanta, GA and John N. Ferrier of Budapest, Hungary. He is survived by five grandchildren: Elizabeth Ferrier, Stephen Ferrier, Greg Hays, Jr., Caroline Hays and Henry Hays all of Atlanta, GA. He is also survived by three sisters: Mignon F. Parker (Tommy) and Claire F. Stahel (Harry) of New Orleans, LA; Marcelle Ferrier of New York, NY; and eighteen nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his oldest son, L. 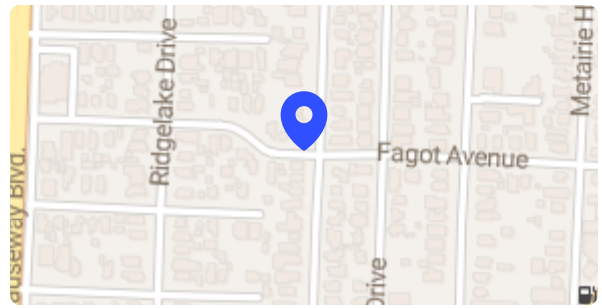

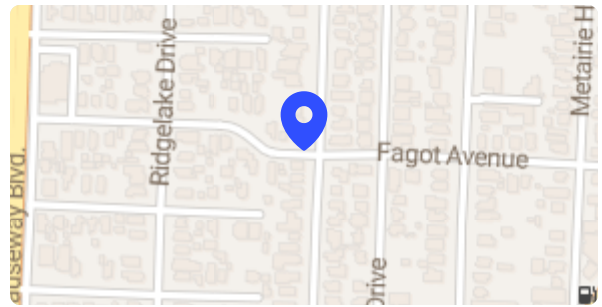
