# Lena Taylor Seeger

JUN 19, 1924 - DEC 10, 2015

**L**ena Taylor Seeger passed away on Thursday, December 10, 2015 at her home in Covington, LA. She was born on June 19, 1924 in Tangipahoa Parish, LA to the late Charles Taylor and Nettie Fitzgerald Taylor.

Lena was married to her beloved husband, the late Charles Edward Seeger. She is survived by their son, Thomas Marion Seeger, his wife Laurie, her loving grandchildren, Thomas Fitzgerald Seeger and Camille Elizabeth Seeger, her sisters-in-law, and numerous nieces, nephews, and their families. Lena was the sister of the late Herbert Taylor and Edna T. Heath.

Lena grew up in Barker's Corner. After graduating from Middle Road and Lyon High (Covington High), she moved to New Orleans in 1944. 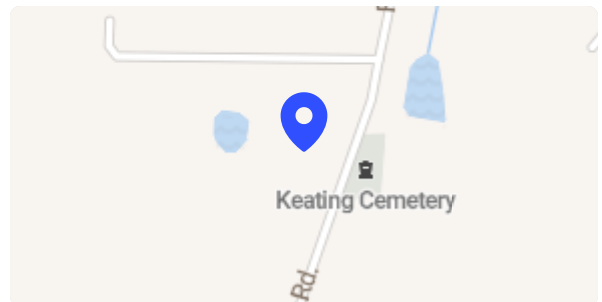

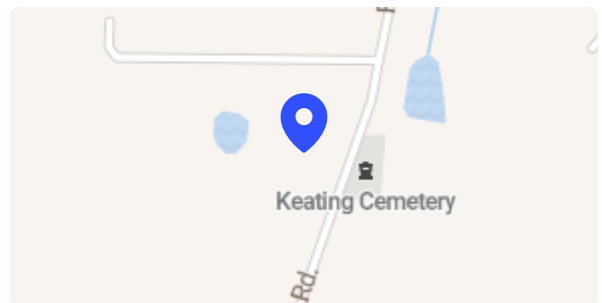

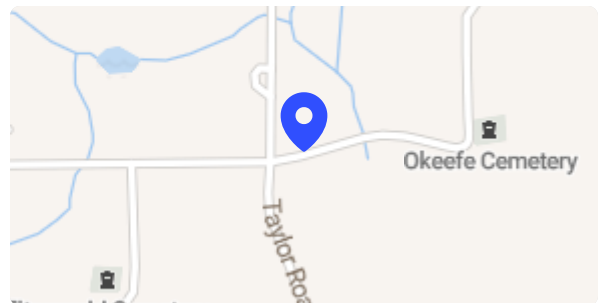
