**D**ollyann Jeanne Guillot, 95 years old, died peacefully in her home at Heritage Manor in Mandeville, Louisiana on Friday, December 25, 2015.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Edna Fallon Guillot (1895-1986) and Walter L. Guillot (1890 to 1976), her sister, Thais (1922-1975), her brother Walter L. Guillot, Jr (1932 to 2012), and her great-nephew Walter L. Guillot IV (1990-2014).

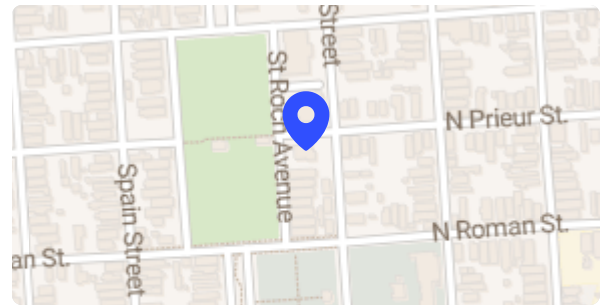

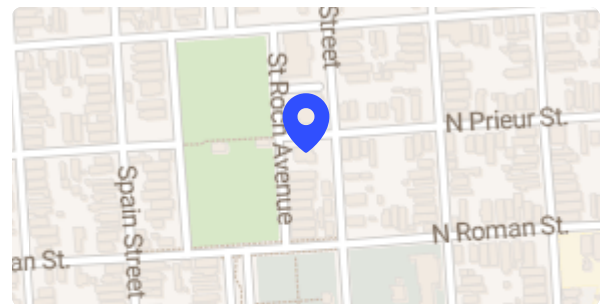

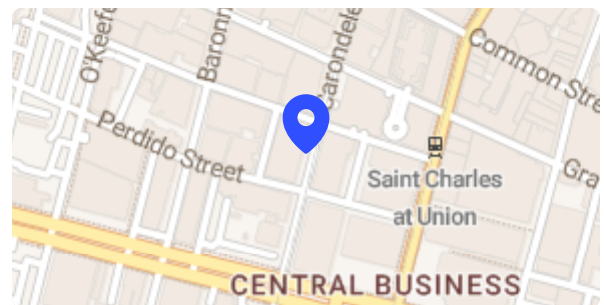
