James (Jim) Stanley Moll entered into eternal rest on Tuesday, April 12, 2016, in Covington, LA. He was born on July 24, 1939 in Waukegan, IL. Jim was married to his beloved wife, Judith (Judy) Twardy Moll for almost 54 years. He was the loving father of five children: Karen (Kari) Moll of Covington, LA; Susie Moll of Dallas, TX; Jamie Moll of Covington, LA; Julie (Glynn) Huhn of Covington, LA; and Scotty (Carol) Moll of Ponchatoula, LA; and five grandchildren: Holly, Cassie, & Holden Huhn and Ella & Lilly Moll. 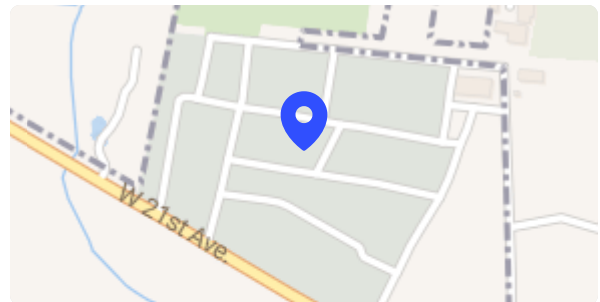

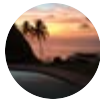

The children played together, played sports together, went to school together, and Judy, Jim, Joleen and I socialized together. In fact, our families spent a Labor Day weekend together in Destin, Florida where we all had a great time enjoying each other's company at the beach. Jim was a big fisherman and got me interested in shrimping with him. We made several trips to Barataria Bay to shrimp in the mid to late 1970's and I always enjoyed being on the water with him, and bringing home shrimp and crabs after a day on the water. A fishing story I can tell about Jim has to do with when we took our two sons – Jamie and Chris – fishing one day on a bayou near Lacombe. I caught a Mullet and was going to throw the fish back when Jim told me to keep it. He said he had a recipe for cooking a Mullet that I would enjoy. He told me to scale and gut the fish, locate a good piece of cardboard, put the fish on the cardboard and season it with salt, pepper and Cajun spices. Finally, I was to put the fish in a slow heat oven for a couple hours. After fully cooked, he told me to take the fish on the cardboard out of the oven, throw away the fish, and eat the cardboard. He said it would be the best Mullet I would ever eat. That story has stayed with me this past 40 years. When Jim and Judy moved to the Covington area many years ago Joleen and I lost contact with them. But as serendipity would have it, we met up again a few years ago and the relationship began again. Although, Judy and Joleen have become good casino friends these past few years, Jim and I haven't had as much contact.
