With six children to raise, she returned to the workforce at Halliburton Services, where she originally met the love of her life, many years before. She worked there until her retirement.

Along with the death of her husband, Betty faced many other hardships. Her father died soon after her husband and she endured the premature deaths of her brother and son. She was a breast cancer survivor and the sole caretaker of her mother for more than 30 years, who died at age 98. Carried through life by her strong faith and love for her Lord Jesus Christ, she was influenced and supported by many loving congregations. Betty was raised in the Catholic church and joined the Gretna Presbyterian Church after her marriage to Herman, where she stayed for 20 years. 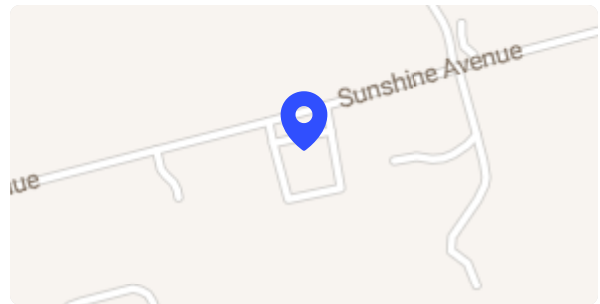

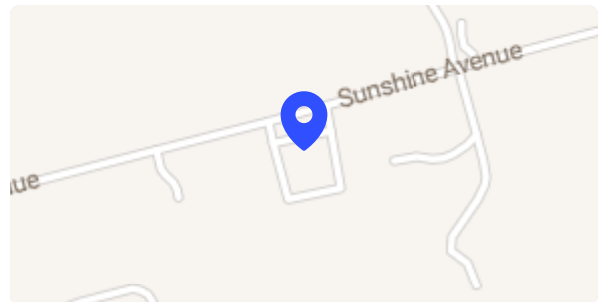

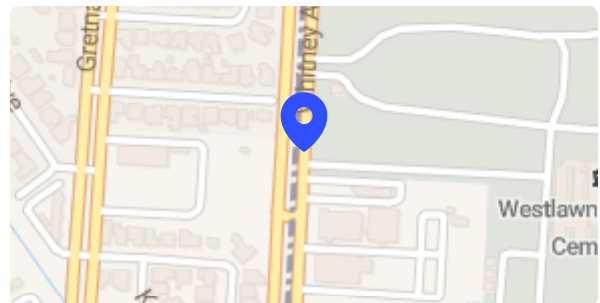
