David is survived by his beloved wife, Valerie. He was the loving father of Katherine Lynd and Susan Lynd Malone, and her husband, Paul Malone.

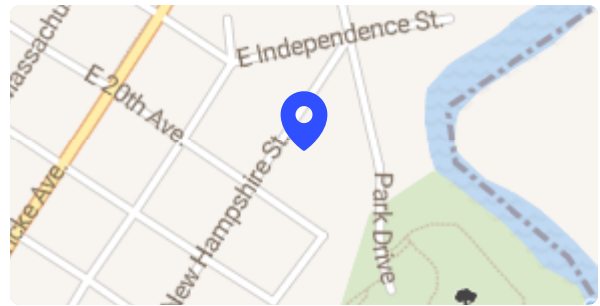

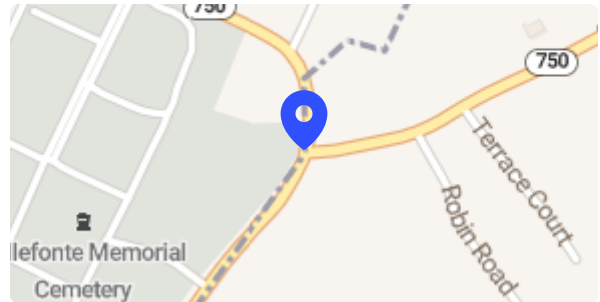
