In lieu of flowers, the family requests donations in memory of Jane to be made to First Baptist Church of Folsom Building Fund.






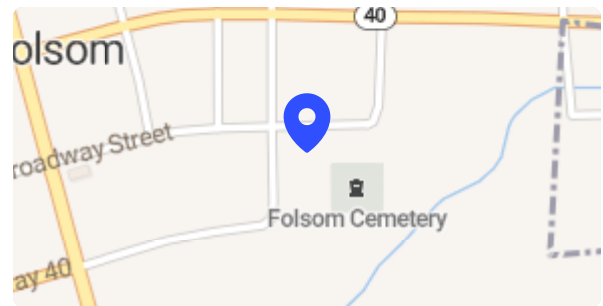
