Wayne Owen Weilbaecher, Jr., age 55 of Marrero, LA passed away peacefully on Tuesday, March 14, 2017, in Covington, LA at his mother's home. He was born, Thursday, June 15, 1961 in New Orleans, LA to Wayne Owen Weilbaecher, Sr. and Fay Marie Brauner-Weilbaecher.

Wayne Weilbaecher, Jr. is survived by his Son, Jonathan W. Weilbaecher, his Mother - Fay Marie Brauner-Weilbaecher, Father-Wayne Owen Weilbaecher, Sr., Brothers - Kurt C. Weilbaecher, Kyle L. 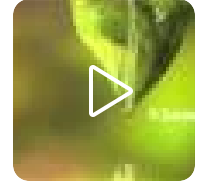
