David Wayne Mayfield, passed away on Monday, April 3, 2017 at the home of his brother in Folsom, Louisiana.

He was born on October 29, 1949 in Levelland, Texas. Shortly after birth, he moved to New Orleans, Louisiana and later to Mandeville, Louisiana. Before recently relocating to this area, he had been a long-time resident of Bastrop, Louisiana.

He was the beloved son of the late J.M. Mayfield and the late Marilyn Autin Mayfield Gorgas. His stepmother was Genevieve Mayfield and his stepfather was the late Irvin Gorgas. He was the loving brother of William (Bill) Mayfield, Ginger Mayfield, the late Rita Mayfield Munez, Martha Hall, and Royce Sheek. He is survived by numerous nieces, nephews, aunts, uncles, cousins, and dear friends.

Upon graduating from Mandeville High School, he received an FCC Engineering Degree in Atlanta, Georgia. 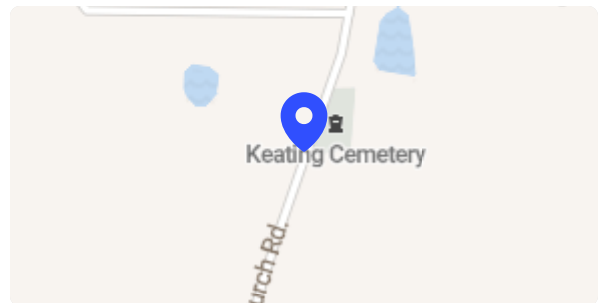

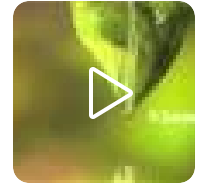
