Calvin "Buck" Leroy Carney of Mandeville, LA passed away on Thursday, June 14, 2018. He was born on March 26, 1943 in New Orleans, LA to Clyde and Irene (Bourg) Carney.

Buck is survived by his beloved wife of over 50 years, Pauline (Lauricella) Carney; his children Stephen Carney and his wife Holly and Jason Carney and his wife Amy; and his grandchildren Hollis, Abby, Katie, Gabby, and John Paul. He is also survived by his sister Iris Lockhart and many nieces and nephews.

He is preceded in death by his parents, his son Brett Carney, his brother Bruce Carney, and his sister Sandra Carney.

Buck served in the United States Navy as a 2nd Class Engineman. He served on USS Tutuila Arg 4, USS Kiowa ATF72, and the USS Oriskany CVA 34. 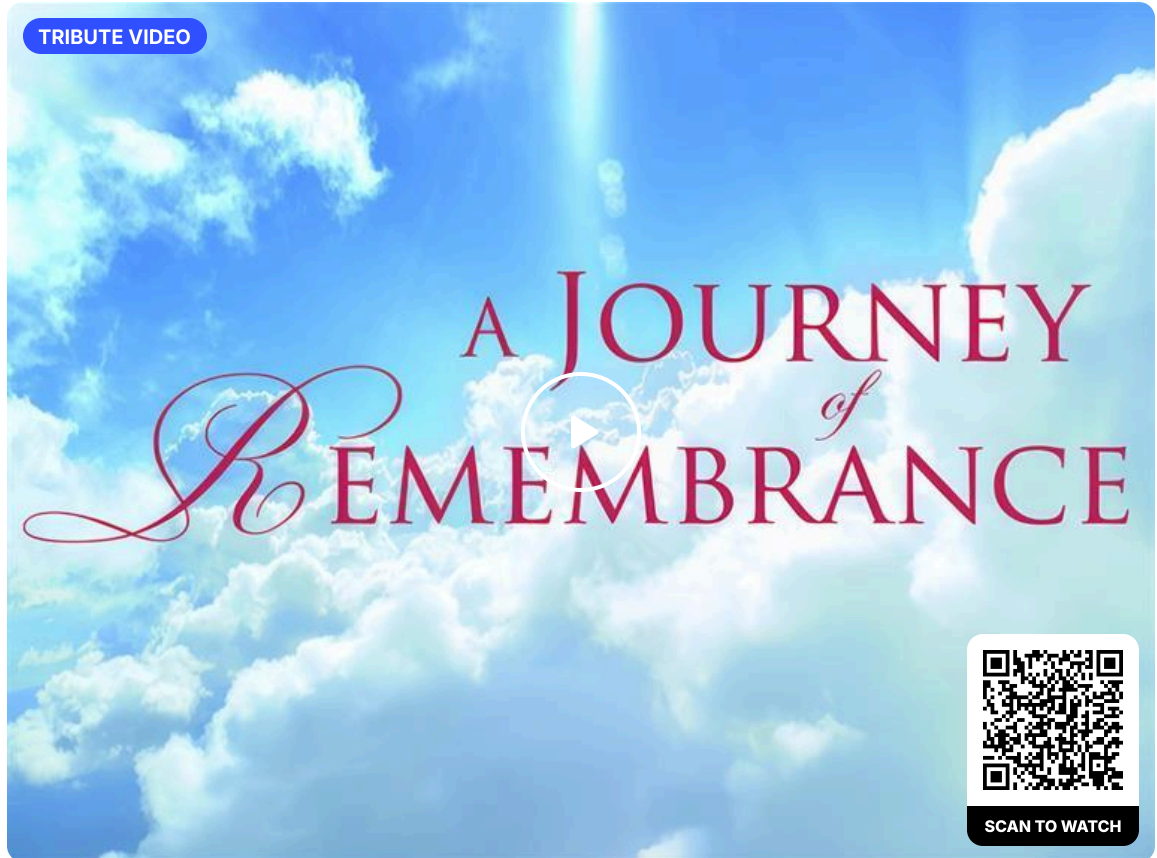
