In lieu of flowers, the family requests donations to help defray the costs of the funeral.






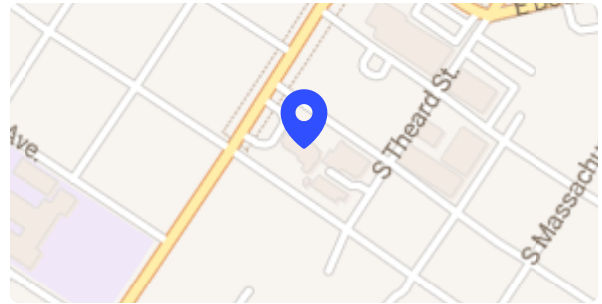

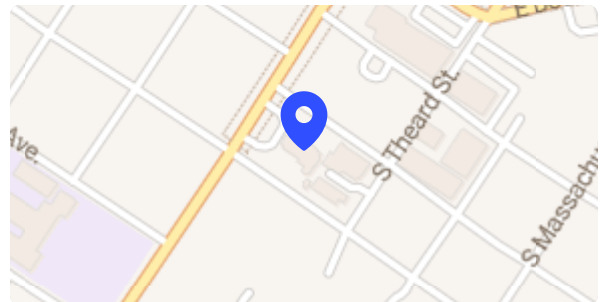
