Ann C. Skelly Masinter Yorsch passed peacefully away on Sunday, December 9, 2018 in Mandeville, Louisiana at the age of 84. 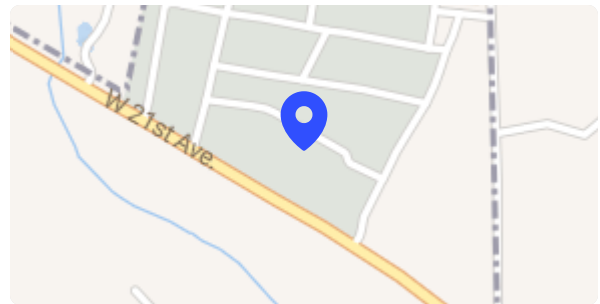

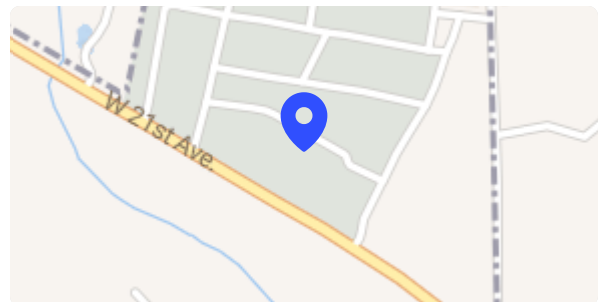

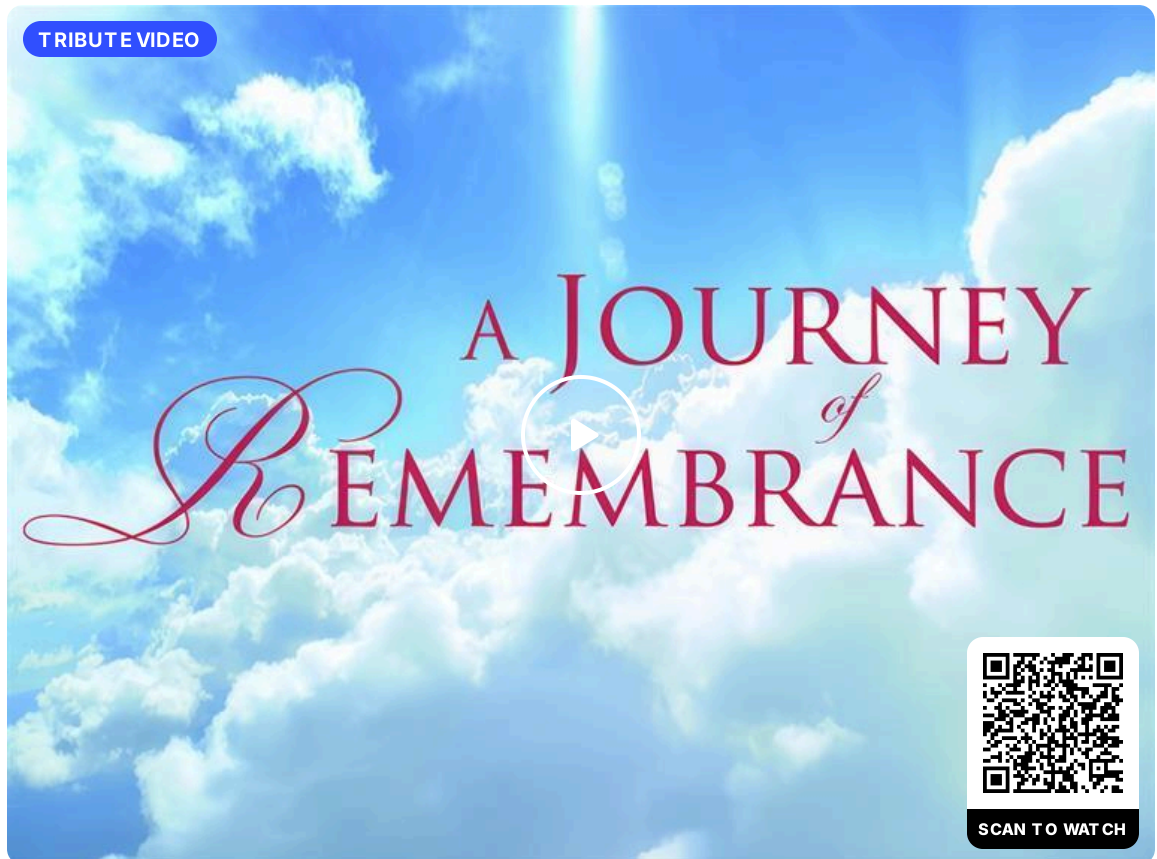
