# Charles Mario Casrill

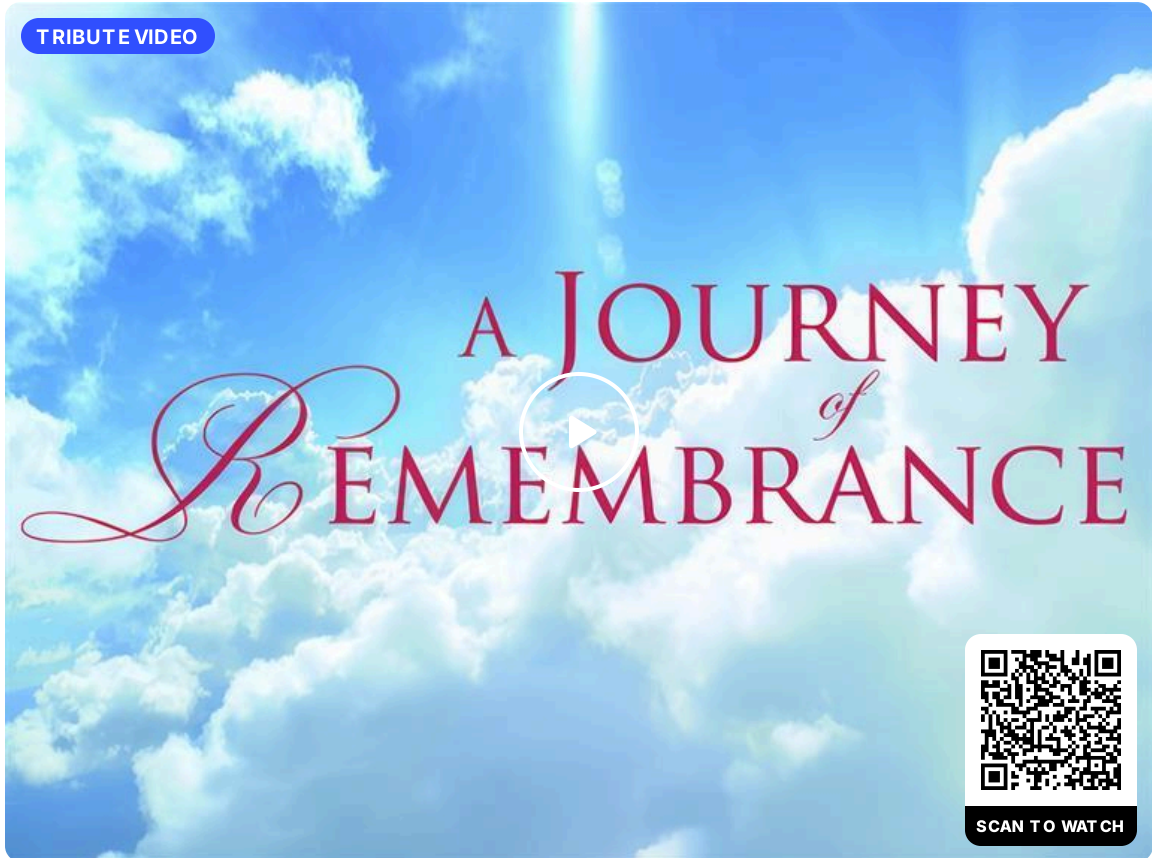
