Interment will follow in Talley Cemetery in Isabel, LA.



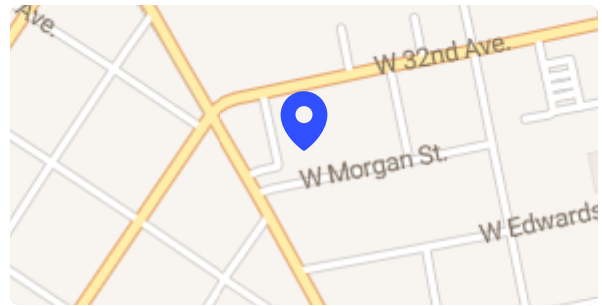

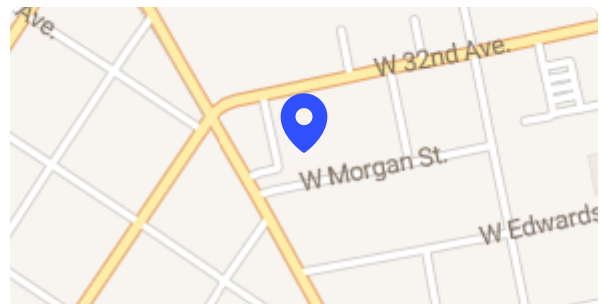

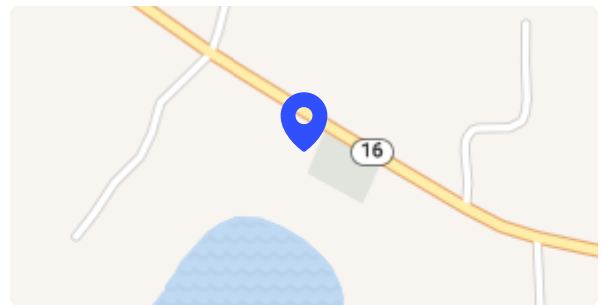
