Patricia Berthelot Brinks passed away on Thursday, February 14th at St. Tammany Parish Hospital in Covington after a very brief but courageous battle with cancer. She was 68 years old.

A native of New Orleans, Patricia was a resident of Mandeville for the past 31 years. She loved her 40-year-career as an educator and treasured the students she taught. She spent the last 22 years as a Special Education teacher at Mandeville Elementary and had no intentions of retiring.

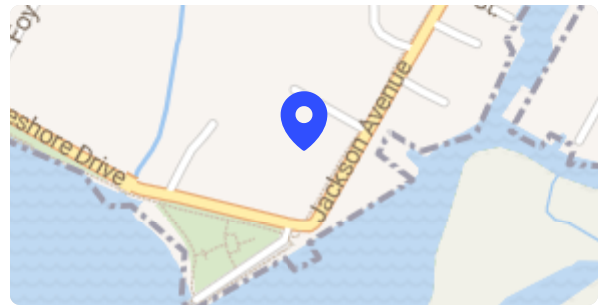
