Lois B. Wager, age 84 of Madisonville, passed away on Saturday, May 9, 2020. She was born on November 25, 1935 in New Orleans, La. to Charles J. and Ida J. Barletto.

Lois married her loving husband, Andrew L. Wager Jr., a school bus driver, in 1956. She worked as a lunch aid at Madisonville Elementary for 19 years. They were married for 49 years- spreading love, kindness and warm smiles to the children of Madisonville. When they weren't serving their community at school, they could be found serving Jesus at Midway Baptist Church in Bedico.

Whether belting out a hymn in church at the top of her lungs or making up silly songs for her children, Lois loved to sing. Even in the last years of her life when her mind started to fail her, her voice never did. She was also known for her delicious, authentic home cooking- which her grandsons' wives will never be able to replicate or truly live up to. 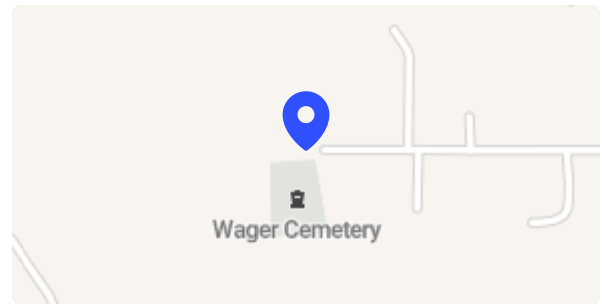
