Dr. Paul P. Hatrel of Covington, LA passed away on Sunday, September 6, 2020. He was born on January 19, 1933 in New Orleans, LA to Thomas Joseph Hatrel and Mildred Barker Hatrel.

Paul was born in New Orleans, La and graduated from Jesuit High School in 1952. He then attended Loyola University and graduated from Loyola Dental School in 1959. Paul then enlisted in the United States Navy and proudly served for over 20 years in the Navy Dental Corp, and retired as a Captain in 1978. Dr. Hatrel worked for LSU Dental School for the next 15 years, before retiring in 1995. In his spare time, he was an avid outdoorsman and enjoyed hunting and fishing and spending time with his family.

Paul was married for 64 years to his loving wife, Adele, and together they had four children.

Dr. Hatrel is survived by his beloved wife Adele (Smith) Hatrel; his children Paul Hatrel (Deidre), David Hatrel (Eileen) and Bryon Hatrel (Bonnie); and his grandchildren Nichole, Thomas "T.J.", Ryan, Tiffany, Christopher, Tyler, Evan, and Davis.
