Morris "Marty" Sharp age 50, of Metairie passed away on Saturday, September 26, 2020. He was born on October 15, 1969, in New Orleans, Louisiana to Royal Edgar Sharp and Norma Rushing Sharp. He was a graduate of Riverdale High School and attended Delgado's School of Drafting and Autocad. Marty worked briefly as an apprentice draftsman prior to enjoying his career as sales associate for Toys R Us for many years, until the store closed. Marty was creative, artistic, and an inventor at heart.

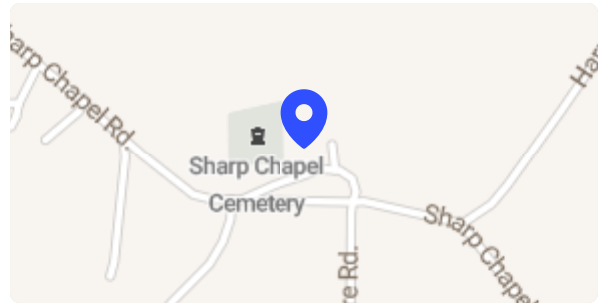

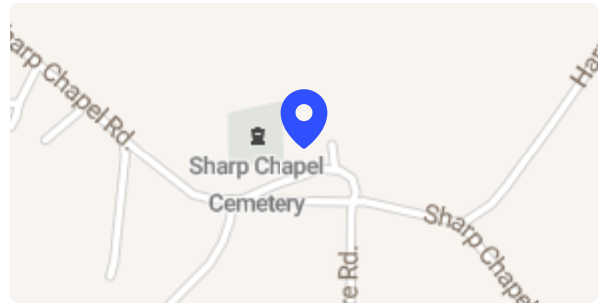
