There will be a reception immediately following the memorial at the home of Patsy Crossett, 261 Arlington Alley West, Covington, La.

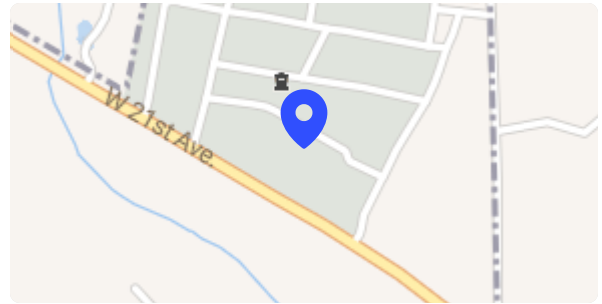
