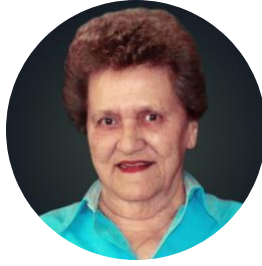

She is preceded in death by her sister, Connie Stein Davis, brother, Malcolm T. Stein, Jr., and sister-in-law, Neva Chustz Stein.

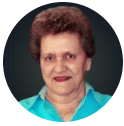
Family was of the utmost importance to Beverly. She was always willing to give assistance when and however needed. She was the ultimate “caregiver” for the family.

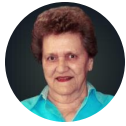

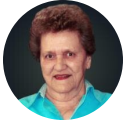
