Arthur David "Art" Daussat passed away on Sunday, August 29, 2021 in Hammond, LA. He was born on November 5, 1945 in New Orleans, LA to the late Arthur Francis Daussat and Eugenie Vandrell Daussat.

Art was the beloved husband of Brenda Vervik Daussat for 51 years. He was the loving father of Ashley Daussat Director (Lane) and Courtney Lynn Daussat.
