After the dissolution of Prestressed, he worked at Lockheed Martin during the construction of the space shuttle. He possessed a great love of his country and the evolution of NASA.

Jackie was an avid football fan and loved the New Orleans Saints. He also loved fishing in and around the Mandeville area, Lake Pontchartrain and Bayou Lacombe, in particular. He enjoyed taking his grandchildren or anyone who was willing to go. He did not care if he caught fish, he just had a love of being out on the water.

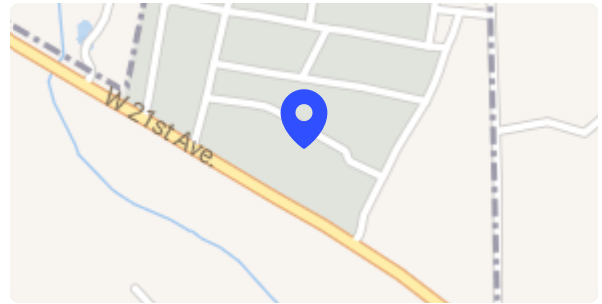

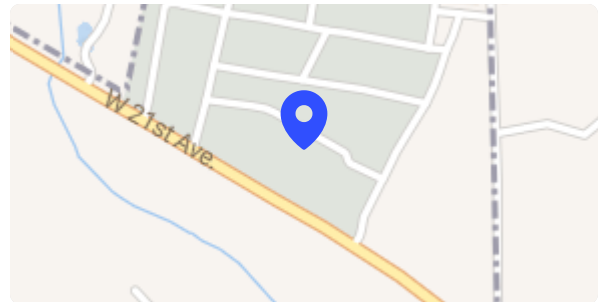

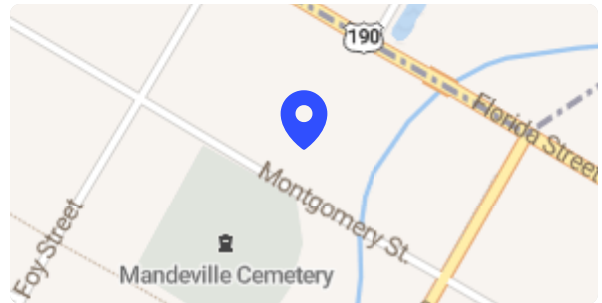
