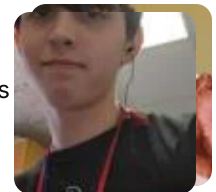

Although he was way off-task, he could still listen and join in on the conversation at any point. His fascination with and understanding of outer space was both endearing and amazing.

His classmates were amazed that I would let them do that, and soon every single student was standing. Then it became a challenge to see who could remain standing for the entire class period.
